Break The Cycle Of Fear Ready or Not! ~Part III

This month is the third anniversary of this newsletter. I so appreciate all of you and pray for you daily as the dear friends you have become.

Truly we live in desperate times. The world seems upside down whether in philosophy, world events, education, politics, weather anomalies – creating social chaos on every side. Which way to turn, we wonder? It is enough to know that our God still reigns and He didn't wake up surprised today at the conditions on earth.

He has a plan and He wants YOU to be part of that plan! Or, a part of the solution and not a part of the problems mentioned above. He is our Rock in the midst of turmoil and confusion. And whether you are on the winning team, is simply a matter of choice, Dear Ones! Your choice.

The future is coming fast and furiously, Ready or Not and the only thing we can do, is P-R-E-P-A-R-E. The best is yet to come. That is...if you are a believer. If not, life in the future looks very scary...if you even dare *think* about it! Even for believers, **what we know** from scripture about the future ...is *frightening!*

The difference between the unbeliever and those who believe in God's power, is believers don't have to fear!

Get out your Bibles and

read Prov. 1:33 & Psalm 46.

The latter says even if the mountains fall into the sea, we will not fear. However... even believers **must choose** not to fear. Il Tim.1:7 tells us that fear is indeed, a spirit! We are not called to a spirit of fear, but ...power, love, and a self control.

So you say, 'I don't have that much faith.' Scripture says, 'faith comes by hearing and hearing by the Word of God.'1 Study scripture & your faith will increase. I promise!1

When I was pregnant for the first time, I learned fear runs in cycles. It's important for all of us to know this principle. A new hospital told our class what to expect. We were led to various rooms in the hospital— waiting & labor and delivery rooms, etc & told what happens in each one.

Then they explained the birthing process and how to make it go more smoothly. One way is to *conquer fear*. They said: First, fear creates tension— tension then creates more fear. More fear creates more tension, and on it goes.

Knowing what to expect helps to break that cycle and curb panic & fear, smoothing out the birth process.

As believers, we know what to expect...! If we <u>are</u> in end times, the future sucks! It's gonna be worse than anything before that's ever happened! Jesus said so...

Resist fear in Jesus' name! Choose to believe the Name of Jesus is higher than any other name that IS named....!

People sitting on their hands waiting for the rapture may well be taken by surprise if it doesn't come on their schedule, wholly unprepared for the future even though they feel they're tight with God. Scripture warns us to "Wake from our stupor..."2

Jesus tells the story of ten virgins awaiting the bridegroom, yet when he finally came, only five had oil for their lamps. The five without wanted the others to share –they would not!

They left to find some oil (at midnight?) Meantime, the bridegroom came and left them behind. Why? **They were unprepared!** Clearly, all virgins had *the same expectation*. Yet 50% of them were left behind.

Yes... the rapture will come for those "who know God **and** obey the gospel' according to II Thes. 1:7-8 Does this describe <u>you</u>?

Let's hope for the best, but **prepare** for the worst – the midnight hour is here! (See back page article).

For certain, we don't want to be lukewarm! Jesus warned-He'll spew us out of His mouth! 3 Don't risk it! Be aglow with the Spirit...on fire for God.4

No one ever says it, but the 7 churches discussed in Revelation is about corruption in the Body of Christ! Read it. Jesus rewarded those who 'kept His word', sparing them 'tribulation'. Yet one who wouldn't repent of teaching wrong doctrine are promised 'great tribulation.'

Watch out, Friends. Churches are corrupt today too! The only plumbline for truth is holy scripture, then and now! 5 Churches too!

The rapture will come, on God's timetable! Don't he left behind, Dear Friends, because you weren't prepared. I've told you what to expect...I don't want these words to come back to you - wishing you'd listened! The warning is clear. Wake up and prepare... while it's light! 6
