In today's world, where converging events and insoluble problems, we might be a little weird or crazy if we didn't have future forebodings.

Jesus promised peace is available in this world, *along with tribulation*.1 So let's look at antonyms to that peace!

Anyone who has spent time in bars, especially dance bars, are driven by high energy. I'm not recommending them, but ...have you ever thought about when people leave those bars, they settle into a quiet church that's boring and predictable!

In other words, the most important story **ever** told is somehow made mundane. How does that happen...? It's the devil's very effective trick called "religion."

Jesus didn't come to create another religion— the world was full of it... then and now. But religion makes church dull. It's why we must have the Holy Spirit—More,we need the anointing that breaks the yoke of bondage. Where one

can put a 1000 to flight and two can put 10,000 to flight.

The Holy Spirit is also the Spirit of Truth...so He doesn't hang around where lies live. That's false religion! The energy of the Holy Spirit is always FRESH.

Make sure your church teaches scripture... and 'faith' for without it, it is impossible to please God! Make certain they acknowledge & invite the Holy Spirit to reign there.

Paul warned of these times. "The Spirit expressly says that in the end times perilous times shall come." 5

They're here. Next month, the Pope is coming to speak before the UN, to talk about **One World Order**. He and France plan to introduce a resolution granting *nation* status to the Palestinians... requiring more Israeli land.

NASA says an asteroid may hit South America next month. **Three** respected voices are predicting a \$100 trillion worldwide economic collapse this fall. As though to confirm it, the Chinese stock market has dropped 35% in 2 weeks time. *Japan* is quaking now

Meantime, God's people are like the disciples were when Jesus came- wanting Him to establish Israel.

real home, where Jesus is! We should be moved with compassion for them; to tears; to prayer for strength!
