

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We, Like Sheeple...

Does it bother you that God calls His people 'sheep'? It has long bothered me, largely because of the nature of sheep. They are completely defenseless; they don't bite or fight, they only run...and that's usually in the wrong direction! They also have absolutely no sense of direction. At all.

In Istanbul, Turkey in 2005, one sheep jumped off a cliff and then nearly 1,500 others followed! Not knowing which way to go, they mindlessly follow others in the flock.

Mindlessly is the operative word there. It bothers me when people who are made in the 'image and the likeness' of God don't use their mind..."unthinkers."

So my question is, why did God make us that way? Is this why Jesus calls Himself the 'Good Shepherd'...? And why we are told 'we like sheep all go astray, each to his own way?' (I read that as our 'doing our own thing!') And: Is being sheep in any way connected to where it says in Eccles. 3:11 "He has set eternity in our heart?"

In other words, we are all hard-wired for God...And that's why everyone is looking for something! Hardcore atheists look to New Age, chrystals, Mysticism or astrology, for guidance! For something, anything to fill that God-shaped void inside us!

If that doesn't work for them, they design their own god, after their own image – like universalism where there is no hell, or cults that deny the truth of scripture.

Lost tribes and aboriginies are noted to have a belief in some sort of deity. Innately, they know murder or theft is wrong. God explains that as 'conscience'- which is 2 words defined 'with knowing.'

It's true that sheep do not think – they just act. That bothers me when people do the same. God gave us a mind, & emotions - to better know & understand Him; to enjoy & engage one another. But we often don't use our minds;yet fear our emotions! So we follow our five senses.

Scripture tells us 'by wisdom we can't know God.'1 So, ever-learning is not the route to salvation. It is the heart that believes; the mouth that confesses Jesus is Lord.2

I have a confession. At one time years ago, I attended many Alanon meetings over a couple of years. I had a loved one addicted to prescription drugs, so I went there for them. Like others, I soon discovered I needed it more than they did!

Upon reflection later, I realized an amazing thing! I'd learned more "life skills" at those meetings (there are some good ones!) than I'd ever learned in churches, since so few provide any real **training** in righteousness.

learned what makes a relationship sick and/or whole. And what my own role was in them. I learned empathy for broken lives like my own. I learned how to encourage others...

This is a primary reason I write these newsletters,(5 yrs in March) to convey life skills that aid others ...based on the truths of scripture.

Even though God crafted eternity in our hearts, and gave us a conscience so that we innately know right from wrong.....we'd usually go our own way in life! Why?

Vanity. We think we know better than God! But...He put those elements in us so we would seek Him.

When I realize people aren't using their minds- it apalls me! Instead we're led

by emotions, fads, trends, latest technology, & idols. Captured by the world ...captivated by *lesser things*.

But... people can't help it! - They're usually doing the best they can. Why? Because they may not be born again.3 Even if they are... they've entered their new life with baggage! Stinkin' thinkin'. Thus, all **new** thoughts go through the same old prism... their minds not renewed via scripture. Read Rom. 12:1-2...

You <u>cannot</u> know the good and acceptable will of God until your mind has been transformed! How? Scripture! Stinkin' thinkin' must GO!

Until our minds are renewed...they're virgin soil, & our lives mostly anemic...!

Your mind is the key to a brand new life! My dictionary defines the mind as: "The agency or part in a human ... that reasons, understands, wills" — **stop** right there! Did you know you can't make decisions without *thinking* first? Are decisions hard for you? Then renew your mind! And "don't let the world squeeze you into its mold but be transformed by the renewing of your mind." (Msg)

'Transformed' in the Greek is *metamorphoses*. YES, phase by phase, we are transformed - via our <u>minds</u> - by scripture! Don't live only by your 5 senses anymore, just guessing.4 Have the faith of God - thinking His thoughts! 5

We're made sheep by the Master Designer so that His abundance can flow thru our emptiness. your "in weakness, find strength."6 It's His secret for use! So we can sow mercy to other broken and sin-sick souls. Those who are ok don't need a physician! Mercy & truth are intertwined in scripture. It's Truth that sets those captives FREE ... 7
