What I Don't Like About 'Love'

A shocking statement, Huh? I won't be presenting some kind of new doctrine here. Or, anything that is in error. No, it is Bible truth many people - especially leaders - somehow miss when it comes to the *truth about Love!* So this needs to be said here.

But, it's easy to miss! Everyone seeks acceptance and approval in life from birth up. And once we hear that scripture says 'God is Love', it's like a freefall from that point on into the lap of love. Or is it...?

In order to gain heaven, it depends on where you go to church or who it is that you listen to. You might get several versions, all the way from 'keeping the right rules' to.... it's all Grace, Brotha....!

Neither approach is what scripture teaches. You must understand that fallen man loves his rules! They appeal to our pride and to self-righteousness. Pharisees of every generation love to 'lord it over' lesser human beings... (in their minds) All popular cults that deny the deity of Christ and legalistic groups or churches are more known for what they are against than ever what they are "for." (like love itself!)

When you flip that coin, we find the other side where no matter what the issue is - you must Love... Sounds 'holy' doesn't it? No error is more flagrant in what is perceived as today's than error! church this Emergent churches and major behemoth churches and denominations of every kind all proclaim this kind of love - that God loves you no matter. And Yes, He does. But there's a problem! He's not like us. Before He is anything else, God is holy.

So this type of 'Love' lacks

godliness – or being like God... Who again, is holy. Dear Friends, there won't be any sin in heaven, so don't try to wear any in there! That's why Jesus came and died!1

In the left margin, Apostle Paul says the love of God is so wonderful, so marvelous that it is incomprehensible. He bids us in that passage to comprehend to incomprehensible! God is so very tender and forgiving and full of mercy. His loving kindness is fresh every morning!2 But He does not tolerate sin in our lives, and truth is, the day we say 'Yes' to Christ, He empowers us to say 'No' to sin! The path to forgiveness & righteous living is ready - if we but only ask.3

This is what I don't like about the kind of 'love' a lot of preachers proclaim. I'm offended at how many who supposedly are lovers of truth warp the Bible's very message! And by doing so, the very nature of God is sullied by their description!

Years ago, this was tagged "sloppy agape," tho I haven't heard that phrase for decades. There is nothing 'sloppy' about God's love – it is clean and fresh and appealing because it's different than any kind of love the world has to offer!

With that latter kind of love, all your words must be dripping with niceties, lest someone be offended from the gospel. Hmmm.... Jesus didn't mind offending folks in Matthew 15.He told Peter that if folks were offended, they were blind guides – and to 'let them alone.' Peter wanted Him to apologize, but Not!

The truth is clear. "All scripture is God-breathed and useful for teaching, rebuking,, correcting and training in righteousness."4 Note a couple of negatives here -

Besides 'teaching & training' there is rebuking & correcting. But you will never hear such a 'negative' in churches that proclaim the licentiousness they call love! And if you say or do anything — You. Are. Out. Of. Order. - thus need training in their brand of Love!

This 'brand' that makes no correction is not the *love of God!* Here's why: "Let us **grow up** speaking the *truth* in love"-that's <u>content + attitude!</u> And God <u>is confrontational – so is the gospel!</u> Because God demands a decision from us! Without a decision to accept His loving plan for our life-we'll coast on to hell. Yes.

A nurse in a huge hospital cared for a dying man on his death bed. In such times, this Christian woman would break hospital protocol and present the gospel to such people. So, she asked him if she could share with him. He said yes. She did so and he listened. After, the man exclaimed "Nah...I don't need that!" And went on to hell! His choice – a free gift offered but he rejected it.

One thousand years from now - he will **still** be crying, "Why didn't I listen to that kind woman?" So what is God to do in such a time as that...? Will 'love' salvage his soul? No. It's the man's choice. Plainly. God did all He could in sending Jesus to die.

"You must be holy, even as I am holy." Faith is reckoned to us as *righteousness* .5

You may be thinking you will get right – before you die. So you think you're in control, do you? **Time** doesn't belong to you, my Friend! You may die in your sleep. Or die in an auto crash where - There. Is. No. Time! I was in a crash once. There was no time to pray. Why take a chance? Today is the day of your salvation...6 Come now!


