## "People Just Like Me..." Were In Hell

I recently watched an interview with a woman on the Sid Roth *Supernatural* Show. Laurie Ditto attended a Christian conference, sitting in the rear, when she experienced a flash of heat in the room. Then she felt her spirit sucked thru heavy gates that slammed loudly. She found herself and others in flames.

She looked around, and she "saw other people just like me - who loved God, - but no one spoke They were all in their personal agony and pain,. She knew she was forever separated from goodness and God. "My full brain operated - I knew every scripture I'd ever known! She knew she'd *never* touch her grandbaby's face again. She said "the worst part was thinking of Jesus in Heaven forgiving me everything. I remembered He said "Obey My commandments" But I *wouldn't!* I would not forgive, not even small wrongs!"

### She came back to testify of this horrifying event.

Reinhard Bonnke is an Evangelist known for his campaigns in Africa and elsewhere, where 500,000 people attend! Through him another man gained recognition, named Daniel Ekechukwu., a Nigerian Christian pastor.

Famous for preaching? No, for **dying!** Daniel was dead over 42 hours .

One weekend, Daniel and his wife had a heated argument, so heated that he dismissed himself to his study and shut the door. She later tried to win his forgiveness, but he would not give it to her or even open his study door to her

It was a Sunday afternoon when he was driving his Mercedes home, and had an accident and crashed into a pole. He died there!

Daniel was taken to the local coroner, where he embalmed his body. This coroner was not particularly a spiritual man.

The next evening, the coroner was inside his house and heard a disturbance of some kind in the mortuary behind the house. He walked out towards it, and heard heavenly music, like a choir. Other bodies were there, but when he walked in, the heavenly sound of that "choir" was just over Daniel's casket.

Meantime, Bonnke was holding a campaign in the area, and Daniel's wife heard about it. She believed in the power of God, and she talked the coroner into taking Daniel's body to the meeting. It was that eerie choir music that made him say 'yes.'

When they got there, security would not permit the coffin to be brought in. So, they took his body out and carried him in. The stage was elevated, so they took his body right below where Bonnke was preaching then.

There, they and others who knew Daniel who joined them prayed for Daniel. His spirit returned & he woke up!

If this isn't astonishing enough, that wasn't the entire story! *It was where Daniel had **been**....!*

An angel briefly greeted Daniel in heaven, showing him around some.

But shortly, the angel took him down thru huge gates, and placed him in a cell. and shut the door. Thinking, **this must be a mistake** he asked the angel why he was there? It smelled hot like sulphur!

The angel responded that if he died that day, that would be where he would *go!* Being a pastor, he was conflicted...

But the angel explained, "*If you would not forgive your wife, then God could not*

forgive you either!"<sup>1</sup> Later on, the angel released him to take this message to the world! He has done so...!

Hell is **REAL**...

We need to **believe** His word is true. **Every** word...

Christians don't take this clear warning to forgive seriously! They feel **Grace** covers everything. Mostly it does... but not *that!*

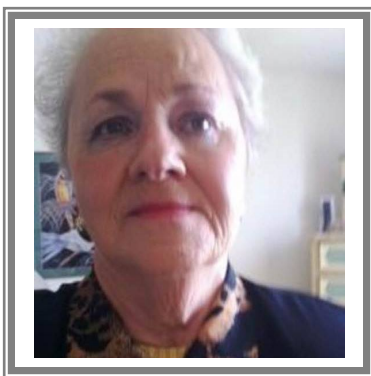
"Consider the kindness & severity of God." Rom. 11.22.. Yes, **Consider** it...

God wants His people to be Holy, like He is, and He provided the way thru Jesus! John the Baptist said "He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and with Fire."<sup>2</sup> Fire can be terrifying! Or, it can cleanse a forest floor for new growth. God uses FIRE to sanctify us, (set us apart) for use by Him. Hence, our *fiery* trials...<sup>3</sup>.

Never heard this before? It's because people today see God as "familiar", like family. Like *themselves!* No, He is not like us. We are *like HIM*. A big difference here. We enjoy singing songs to worship *the God we **think** He is!* Better look again at His Holy Word! And realize the most holy word that is uttered inside is to OBEY His commandments. Jesus said, "If you love me, you'll KEEP my commandments."

The truth is, Hell will be full of religious people. Why? Because Jesus also warned, "Not everyone who SAYS Lord, Lord shall enter Heaven but those the DO the will of the Father." <sup>4</sup>

*Miracles* in Matthew 7:21-23 don't qualify you for heaven... just simple DOING His Word!! Romans 8 tells you how to OBEY it by following the **Spirit's leading**. *not our flesh-self.*

You might as well give it up... it's impossible! Holiness is not a warm & fuzzy feeling! Only spiritually hungry people can experience it.

Initially, we are all born after the natural man, the first **Adam**. So then, we are inclined to go our own way, and do our own thing. We think we know how to live our lives better than God knows...and *that's* the way we are! You might as well resolve as the Apostle Paul did, "For I know that there is no good thing that dwells in my flesh." 5

But! You have the opportunity to have God Himself live out thru YOU when you are rightly related to Him... and there's **no greater thrill in life!**

That's why God stepped into the picture, and sent the **last Adam**, 5 a new man in Jesus! One who 'was touched with our infirmities' and 'tempted as we are.' 6 God made it possible for us to live that holy life, and it's why Jesus told us we must be born again. But it is only thru that *new man* that it is possible to be holy!

Nicodemus asked "How can a man enter his mother's womb and be *born again*?" 7 Jesus said **You are thinking natural**, Nicodemus! Think supernaturally!

First, unless we are born again, we cannot **see** the Kingdom of God. And secondly, we must be born again to **enter** into it. It is a wholly spiritual matter!

But if we will humble ourselves like a

little child 8 – you can discern spiritual matters & enter in God's Kingdom now

. When we agree with God that our condition is lost, separated from Him, and have followed only our 5 senses, then we're a candidate for salvation .(Not until then!) We each were originally God's idea. He made us in His **image** and His **likeness**, (similar to Him) to fulfill His plan on earth! There are multitudes whom he wants to be in heaven with Him for eternity.. But unless they HEAR the gospel,... they *won't be!* This is where you come in –He authoriaes you to be a messenger. Aking in faith is necessary. 9

This is the first avenue of becoming holy. It's not anything of ourselves, but what Jesus did for us. Faith is required, because without it, it is impossible to please God. "Anyone who comes to Him must believe that He exists and that He *rewards* those who earnestly seek Him." 10

I believe with all my heart...we can't just leave God on the shelf after that!. This is the route to change your life & becoming fruitful. Some just need to *grow up* ,.I know I did!

The best indicator in your life of a relinquished & holy life, is that you get up in the morning and give your day to the Lord, by spending time with Him, using scripture or a devotional, and prayer. Else, He doesn't have your **day!** Or, maybe **you**...

Refueling is necessary... we need *re-charging*. Keeping a close tab on your sins by asking in repentance, keeps you **holy**. Without holiness, no man will see God. 12

I agree with you that they don't deserve forgiveness ....But you must realize **you don't deserve it** either, and now you've tied God's hands from being able to bless or even help you—when He really wants to do so! Your sins have separated you from God. He can't look at you.. See Isaiah 59:2

The thing is, forgiveness is not about **them**... It's about **you**, Rita. It isn't a matter of whether he deserves forgiveness. We all are undeserving scoundrels at heart.. The *world, flesh & the devil* made us that way! We are all broken & need Jesus to make us whole. Don't you long for wholeness after this?

Did you know that bitterness is unforgiveness gone to seed? And when we become bitter, we find we are in a vicious cycle where we discover that *we are bitter ...because we're bitter!!*

**Bitterness 'defiles.'** 11.

People don't realize it defiles us and those around us too! Yes...

If we make bad choices and give place to the devil, then he can have it! It's like an invitation to him to operate. That's why **our** decisions *change lives* around us...whether wise choices or bad ones!

Is withholding forgiveness from him and/or her worth risking being in Hell, forever and ever and ever ? S.A.N.E. people would say "No".

Did you even **read** the front article? **Truth is, you won't forgive them.**

Forgiveness is not an emotion – you don't have to FEEL it to give it! It is a matter of the WILL where you simply CHOOSE to do so. It's that simple, Rita! Withholding it is a price too high to pay...!
