Are You A Foreigner....to God?

Would it surprise you that I've been in jail 3 times in my life? I also lived five years doing disgraceful things. It is *all* in the book I wrote...

But God knows me well, and He has forgiven me all those things...I'm comfortable with His presence...now

Marilyn Nelson, a member of our group that meets on Fridays read the book and she appraised it well... She said *"The book is good! It is raw and personal. Finding God in this world is our Rock."*

I found God. The **Real God**. Many think they know Him, but Jesus said "few" would choose the real path. He said "many" thought knew Him..but they were strangers to Jesus!

I was a 'foreigner and a stranger' to God and His people on the earth, according to Apostle Paul.¹

This explains it:

"Downton Abby was a British TV drama that follows the fictional Crawley family as they navigated a changing social structure in early 1900's England. One of the key characters was Tom Branson, initially worked a chauffer to the family, before shocking everyone by marrying the youngest Crawley daughter. After a period of exile, the young couple returned to the Downton Abbey and Tom became part of the family, gaining access to rights and privileges he had been denied as an employee."²

You don't have rights in the household of God, if

you are a foreigner and a stranger to God.

First, He cleans you up and places a robe of righteousness on you- This defines repentance of your sins, if you **change your mind** about God. We live in a broken world & so we are broken – not living up to standards of God. *All have sinned..*³ Jesus took our sins on the cross...⁴

Second, Jesus gave you the keys to His Kingdom, as a family member of the church. That means ownership & authority! Many don't walk in this authority & ownership; ...they don't understand what they possess. I've studied it over five decades & I know **what** we possess! His Name's Wonderful, Full of Wonder...and gifts on earth & future...

This is the last verse of Proverbs 1! But if you read the previous verses, God says if you don't believe in Him, He'll not answer you in your calamity....!

Choose God now!⁷

"Being a member of God's family brings incredible rights & privileges. We can approach God with freedom & confidence. Regardless of our backgrounds..."²

Forgiven by Grace!

God made us in His image and He feels the same way we do...He hates wickedness! He actually calls people *stupid*. That's what Proverbs 12:1 says...

Amen.

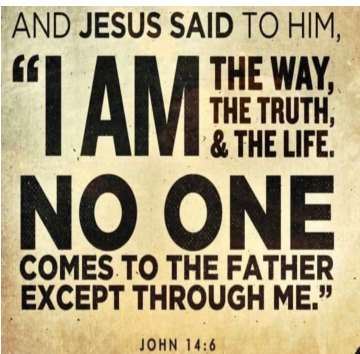

What Wisdom Does Proverbs Say...?

Fear of the LORD is the BEGINNING Of Knowledge. Proverbs 1:7

God is Awesome... Wonderful too! Full of Wonder –He made all the earth & the world, and Psalm 19:1 says what He **made**, *never stops speaking...* and Romans 1:19+ says “*For what can be known about God is plain to them... For His invisible attributes, namely, His eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly perceived ever since the creation of the world, in the things that have been made. So they are **without excuse**.”¹¹*

A lot of Christians say you have to Love everyone! But it's not what the Bible says... *O you who love the Lord, Hate evil.*¹¹ Psalm 36 defines wicked:

1. *There is no fear of God in his eyes.*
2. *He flatters himself in his own eyes that his iniquity can't be found out and hated.*
3. *The words of his mouth are trouble and deceit.*
4. *He has ceased to act wisely and do good.*
5. *He plots trouble on his bed.*
6. *He sets himself in a way that is not good.*
7. **He does not reject EVIL.**

This culture we live in does not reject **Evil**. Did I say we live in a broken world...? We live in a generation that's degenerate. And wicked people don't even have the sense to blush...¹²

“*Fear is the BEGINNING of Wisdom.*”¹³ Proverbs eight lists the Qualities of Wisdom. It has 36 verses. Vs 13 says “*The fear of the LORD “**IS**” hatred of EVIL...*”

Do you know that knowledge is WHAT,,,? And wisdom is... HOW?
